WHO CAN APPLY?

Any current or former PFA member.

GRANT CRITERIA

- All applications are subject to strict administration checks.
- Funding is available towards courses which lead to a nationally recognised accredited qualification.
- Funding is processed at 50% of eligible course fees.
- Funding is available upon completion of the qualification.
- Members can claim a maximum of £2,000 within a PFA financial year (1st July - 30th June)
- Education funding is capped at a lifetime amount of £7,500 for each member.
- Claims must be made within 6 months of the course end date.
- Claims for private tuition/private lessons are not eligible for funding.
- An enhanced rate of funding may be available for members who are registered as unemployed and in receipt of benefits. You are advised to complete the Application Form and return along with evidence you are currently registered as unemployed and details of the training course you would like to undertake.
- Our criteria and levels of funding are subject to regular reviews to ensure that we can carry on helping as many members as possible within the limits of the funds available. Consequently, grant payments may vary over time and as such this document should not be viewed as a definitive guide.
