WHO CAN APPLY?

Any current or former PFA member.

BURSARY CRITERIA

- All applications are subject to strict administration checks.
- Members undertaking an undergraduate or postgraduate degree in the UK or abroad can apply for a Bursary at the start of each academic year.
- The Bursary amount for full-time study is up to £1,250 per year.
- If studying part time, a pro-rata figure is calculated based on the number of credits being undertaken.
- The Bursary is to help with IT equipment, books, software, travel, living costs and other study related expenditure.
- You should note whether you are living at home, or away in separate accommodation. Approximate yearly cost should also be entered.
- Any member withdrawing from their Degree Programme may be requested to reimburse their Bursary.
- Education funding is capped at a lifetime amount of £7,500 for each member.
- Members attending University must claim during each academic year (cut-off date 30th June).
- Our criteria and levels of funding are subject to regular reviews to ensure that we can carry on helping as many members as possible within the limits of the funds available. Consequently, grant payments may vary over time and as such this document should not be viewed as a definitive guide.
